SITUATION

Hundreds of firefighters fought a fire that engulfed an auto body supply store in in Lawndale on Chicago's West Side.

PROBLEM

The insurance company initially offered only \$1.4 million dollars to the store and tried to get away with this sum by threatening penalties and using confusing language.

RESULTS


Our team wound up settling the building for an impressive sum of \$6.3 million.

While the insurance company also only offered an initial \$350,000, we received a settlement of \$1.2 million for the business personal property. Plus, we also were able to secure \$280,000 in monthly loss of income ongoing to date.

We increased a building collapse settlement from \$300,000 to \$1.1 million.

A commercial building in Willowbrook, Illinois, with a bow truss roof collapsed from the heavy weight of ice and snow.

The insurance company initially offered a sum of \$300,000. However, our team settled the claim for \$1.1 million.



We recovered a high rise in only 90 days, after a fire sprinkler burst.

A fire sprinkler burst in a High Rise in downtown Chicago and caused extensive water damage.

Our team managed the enter recovery process from repairing the building to securing a high settlement.

The insurance company originally offered \$400,000; however, we settled the claim for just under 1 million.

We also repaired all 45 units of the building within only 90 days.



We recovered over \$188,000 after insurance offered nothing.

After a pipe burst in a home in Kenosha, Wisconsin, our 24/7 emergency service team rushed to the scene for a thorough structure drying and stablization.

Initially, the insurance company offered up zero dollars with the following reason: the insured caused there own loss.

Our team successfully combated this claim and recovered \$188,000 for the homeowner. We also got all emergency fees covered and more.



We recovered over \$4 million in loss of income after a tornado destroyed a Nashville hotel.

After a tornado tore through Nashville, tons of properties and building were left destroyed.

The Fieldhouse Hones Hotel was hit especially hard, with ony half the building left standing. Our team mobilized and managed the entire emergency service.

We sent our trucks and a semi to Nashville and stabilized the hotel from water overflow. Our team also powered up the building with generators.

The hotel was brand new and had no income yet- but we was were still able to recover over \$4 million in loss of income, and secured all the appropriate funds to build the hotel back up.
